## I. Call to Order – President Ryan

President Ryan called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM and led the community in the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### II. Superintendent's Report – Mr. Weiss

Superintendent's Report

Superintendent Outreach Meetings with community have begun in

both private homes and the office; primary current concerns involve MS and HS curriculum changes and construction issues. Communication is key factor with stakeholders having opportunity for input before decisions are made. Supt. Weiss will meet with Board in early fall regarding MS curriculum/heterogeneous structure. Presently, disproportionate number of minorities opting out of honors opportunities. After careful analysis of the program, with clear gains in the lower and middle range of students, the HS will continue with the plan of heterogeneous groupings for 10th grade English. Rigor will be major focus. Dialogue will continue. Long term plan will be formulated.

## Construction Update - Mr. Michael DeVito

Informal Neighbor Meetings are in progress. Information has been disseminated through flyers which were sent out, door to door canvassing, and through the mail. Current construction status at the HS, Lido Complex, East School, West School, and Lindell School was detailed.

- President Ryan asked about building visitations on August 30th. There was discussion about the completion of work before the school year. Supt. Weiss questioned the condition of the schools for the opening of school. Mr. DeVito confirmed that although schools will be open on time, there will be some differences in the structure of the Lido complex, HS, and East School. HS pool has reopened with new state of the air chlorinator that will improve conditions of pool, cleaner tiles, new lighting.
- Board Member Guma appreciated East School meeting notices and information
- Board Member Gallagher spoke about the Quiksilver Pro tour from September 1 15 and asked
  the Superintendent about its effect on our school community. Supt. Weiss and Mr. DeVito met
  with City Hall Officials. If weather and surf permits, Quiksilver will be done by September 10<sup>th</sup>.
  Concerns about transportation have been addressed by city, working on providing information
  about event to all schools and capitalizing on sense of pride about Long Beach amongst
  students.
- Board Member Tangney voiced her concerns about truancy during the time of the event and loss
  of revenue. Most events will not run during school hours. Supt. Weiss discussed possibility of
  streaming competition into the schools and having some competitors visit schools.
